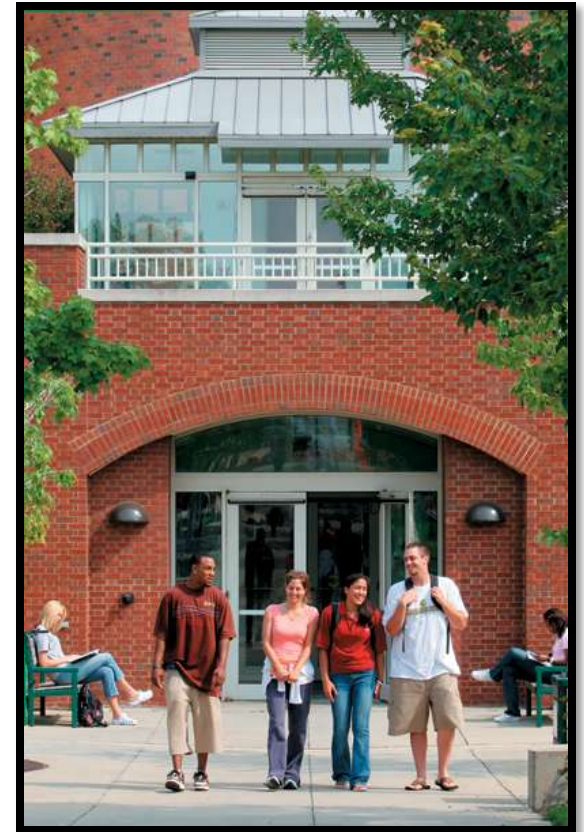

Who are we?

- Board certified physicians
- Certified nurse practitioners
- Student front desk staff
- We work closely with the CSU Counseling Center & Disability Services on an as needed basis



Who can use Health and Wellness Services (HWS)?

- Any currently enrolled student
(we will see students over the summer if enrolled for spring & enrolling for fall)
- CSU faculty and staff



What types of services do we offer?

- Basic medical care
- Treatment of minor injuries and illnesses
- Immunizations, Tb tests
- Physical exams
- STD/STI testing, gyn care, birth control, emergency contraception
- Screening tests
- Health education
- Wellness programs
- Anything your student would go to your family doctor for



Does your student need health insurance to use HWS?

- No - we offer care to the entire University community regardless of insurance status
- If your student does not have health insurance and needs a level of care we can't provide, we will try to help him/her obtain discounted medical care at local hospitals
- As per HIPAA regulations, all student health records are private



What does it cost?

- We bill most health insurance companies . No visit co-pay or co-insurance is charged. If all charges go toward your deductible, only lab work or vaccine costs at the low self pay rate will be charged to the student
- If you have no insurance or one that we don't bill, we will charge fees at the self-pay rate. No cost for provider only visit.
- If you have the student health insurance, everything done in the health center is covered at 100%



Does CSU offer health insurance?

YES!!

- All undergraduates enrolled with 6 or more credit hours are eligible
- All graduate students enrolled with 1 or more credit hours are eligible
- Insurance carrier is United HealthCare SR
- Semester or whole year plans available
- Mandatory referral requirement for outside care

What if my student gets sick and HWS is not open?

- If the illness is not an emergency and can wait until HWS reopens, students can call at 8:10 am for a same day appointment. They can also call the 24-hour nurse help line at **1-877-643-5130**
- If a medical emergency arises on campus, or at home, students should call 911 for help
- Campus police may be available to transport to an ER or an ambulance will be called
