3. Office of Research Update

a. Graduate Faculty Research Support Program

- The Office of Research received five applications for the month of January
- All five applications were funded
- Funds are distributed on a rolling basis as long as funds are available

b. Grant Tuition Program

- The Office of Research supports the Grant Tuition Program (GTP)
- The Office of Research committed tuition support for graduate students with stipends paid out of research grants that generate full federal IDC
- Support provided by college:
 - COSHP – 6 students
 - Engineering – 3 students
 - Education – 1 student
 - Intercollegiate – 1 student

- c. Library, Open Access, Cambridge University Press
