The CSU Online Parking System allows CSU students, faculty and staff to manage their parking accounts 24/7! Purchase permits, manage vehicles, view letters, etc. Campus visitors have the ability to create a guest account on the system and register their vehicle. By using the CSU Online Parking System, CSU students, faculty and staff choose where they want to park based on their personal budgets. CSU has several products available, including prepaid permits, hourly and short-term parking at Pay Stations, coin meters, and in automated garages.

Interested in a Prepaid Permit?

Choose a White, Green, Evening or Night Permit and you may park in any lot associated with that permit (the permit receipt lists all the parking zones and privileges).

Here's how the parking system works:

- > White Permits provide access to *non-core*, *perimeter parking* (including access to the South Garage) by swiping your Viking Card.
- Screen Permits provide access to core parking and the South Garage by swiping your Viking Card.
- Night and Evening Permits provide access to core and non-core lots and garages after specific times (except South Garage, Prospect Garage and Visitor lots).
- > Prospect Garage (PG) is restricted to:
 - a) a limited number of students living in a University residence hall, and
 - b) a limited number of employees.
- Motorcycle Parking information is available on the parking website: csuohio.edu/parking/motorcyclebicycle-parking or purchase in the parking office.

Where to buy permits

CSU prepaid parking permits should be purchased via the CSU Online Parking System: csuparking.T2hosted.com. Log in with your CSU ID and password. Permit sale dates: August 1, December 1 and April 1*.

- > Employees may pay by credit card* or payroll deduction as the payment method. *Visa, MC and Discover are accepted for payment via the CSU Online Parking System.
- » Daily/hourly parking is accepted at Central (East 21st only), East*, South, Prospect and West Garages. *East Garage after 3 p.m. weekdays and all day on weekends.
- > Short-term parking is available in various locations at digital Pay Stations: Lot 22 (Student Center), Rec Garage (RG), Lot 20, Lot 21, Lot 40, Lot 54, Lot 66, and Lot 70. Patrons may also purchase through Text2Pay for a small service fee. P-Code required. Visit csuohio.edu/parking/text2pay for details.
- Green and White permits are valid for parking in designated parking locations from 5 a.m.-11:59 p.m. daily. Evening and Night permits are restricted to the time listed on the receipt.

RTA U-Pass

CSU students taking one or more credit hours on the main campus save money on RTA transit fare, as well as on parking and gas money. Students are automatically charged the fee on their Student Account for a U-Pass, which is good for unlimited rides on RTA for an entire semester. **Don't forget that most RTA buses have bike racks!**

CSU encourages and welcomes bicycle commuters. Bicycles do not require a registration on the CSU campus. As such, bicycles are not permitted to park in vehicle spaces.

- The Bike Rack The city of Cleveland and The Downtown Cleveland Alliance offer the region's first full service bicycle parking and commuter center. The Bike Rack welcomes bicyclists with the convenience of secure bicycle parking and fulfilling everyday commuting needs with individual shower/changing facilities, lockers, bicycle rentals and a full-service bicycle repair shop.
