**College/ Program Notes:**

The plan above is a suggested guide to ensure that all General Education, College, University, and Major requirements are met within 4 years of study. Students may deviate from the suggested placement of Gen Ed courses, although the M/QL and W/C requirements should be completed during the first year of study.

\*General Electives ensure that a student accumulates the minimum credit hour totals needed for graduation. Students must have a minimum of 120 total credit hours, of which a minimum of 36 credit hours must be upper division (300 or 400-level courses). Depending upon other elective choices made, students may not need as many general electives as indicated above, or may need additional electives.

**Core Curriculum Key:**

IL = Inquiry Launch (one course)\*\*

FYV = Finding Your Voice (one course, C or better required)

SI = Scientific Inquiry (two courses, one lab credit)

GHP = Global Human Perspectives (one course)

QFR = Quantitative & Formal Reasoning (one course)

\*\* *Inquiry Launch requirement is waived for transfer students.*

RPW = Research & Professional Writing (one course, C or better required)

HCC = Human Culture & Creativity (one course)

WAC/SPAC = Writing/Speaking Across the Curriculum Req (2 courses, one in the major)

AAHC = African-American History & Culture (one course)

DiS = Diversity in Society (one course)

DDL = Data & Digital Literacy (one course, can be satisfied by a second FQR course)

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
