



Title: A Resolution Favoring Student-Inclusive Decision Making (SR-4-2025)

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WHEREAS, Cleveland State University sometimes fails to allow for a dialog surrounding larger strategic changes to occur before such changes are finalized;

WHEREAS, this lack of dialogue can result in unforeseen circumstances presenting themselves to administrators, forcing reactive rather than proactive action;

WHEREAS, these reactive occurrences are detrimental to both the Student Body and the University that is supported by the aforementioned students' tuition; and

WHEREAS, the Cleveland State University Student Government Association exists to advocate for the interests of the student body;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Student Government of Cleveland State University hereby:

1. Request that, whenever permissible under the circumstances, administration make intended courses of action and strategic positions public, and
2. Request that, whenever permissible under the circumstances, administration solicit feedback on the aforementioned publicly-stated positions, by method of campuswide email survey, and
3. Request that, when positions or actions must be kept confidential, a valid written justification for why such information was concealed from University stakeholders is produced and provided to the Student Body after the decision is made public.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that copies of this resolution shall be distributed to all SGA members, made available online, and made available to the student body upon request.
