RE: SGA Fall 2025 Special Election Results

The Student Government Association Fall 2025 Special Election was conducted over a 24-hour period approximately one month after the start of the academic year with the following results:

Total Ballots Cast: 333

Participation Change: 32% increase from Spring 2025 first-day results

CONSTITUTIONAL REFORM RESOLUTION

The following resolution was presented to the student body for approval:

RESOLVED: The Student Government Association constitution and governing documents shall be updated to achieve the following reforms:

Expanded Funding Access

Remove the General Fee Unit designation requirement, enabling all registered student clubs and organizations to apply for and receive SGA financial support.

Independent Election Oversight

Transfer election administration and oversight from SGA to an independent, impartial entity to ensure fair and transparent election processes.

Organizational Efficiency

Eliminate redundant appointed positions and consolidate decision-making authority with elected senators to improve accountability and reduce administrative waste.

Enhanced Student Participation

Implement open voting procedures at SGA meetings, allowing broader student body participation in funding decisions and policy matters.

Resolution Results

Approved: 94% (313 votes)

Opposed: 6% (20 votes)

Status: PASSED
