
# Chart Key

Non-Returning Students were contacted, and non-return reasons were recorded as listed below:


- **Academics** - students who transferred, did a late withdrawal, or were a CCP or non-degree seeking student and did not need to return this semester to continue their studies
- **Financial** - student had a balance that could not be resolved and were unable to return
- **Personal** - family or health issues prevented students from returning
- **Non-responsive** - students did not respond to coach outreach, therefore reasoning unknown





Students Not Returning - 83




Fall '25 First Time Students Not Returning - 4




# College of Engineering

Students Not Returning - 70




Fall '25 First Time Students Not Returning - 21



Students Not Returning - **132**





Students Not Returning - 47




